We will open the church for private prayer at the following times when services normally take place:

Monday to Friday	9am – 10am
Saturday	5:30pm – 6:45pm
Sunday	9am - 11am 5:30pm – 6:45pm

NB: in accordance with further instructions from the Archbishop, in line with government guidelines, the church will now be **closed** at all times, and consequently unavailable for private prayer.
