Holiday time begins for many this weekend. I hope the situation we are in at this difficult time does not spoil your breaktime.

I would also like to say a very big thank you to those who have continued to contribute financially to the parish. As you can imagine we have had a very big drop in our collection and the diocese is still charging parishes the same diocesan taxes.
