## Message from Canon Alan

Hi Everyone

These last two weeks have given me great joy as the community have slowly come back to mass and expressed their joy at being back to celebrate Mass. The feeling has been completely mutual.

I am delighted that so many have expressed that the redecorating has made the church look so wonderful. We are now as the original architect wanted the church to look. The simplicity of the design truly enhances the shapes of our very special church.

I wish to express my thanks to John and Simon at Albins, who contributed half of the cost of the redecoration. Without their generosity we would not have been able to do the refurbishment during lockdown. I am also very grateful to Dominic and his team who did the work at a greatly reduced price. Over the years they have been extremely generous to us. The Sacristy and many jobs in the house have been down to them. With a few loans, the whole thing has cost twenty-one thousand. The last estimate I got four years ago was thirty-one thousand pounds. If anyone wants to contribute to the redecoration, I would be most grateful.

I am very grateful to those who have offered to be stewards, readers, servers and Eucharistic Ministers during this unlocking stage. Without your help our church would not be open. We have still a number of parishes who are not able to open. During the month of August, we will not have weekday masses but only at weekends. I know that some of you will be disappointed but as the situation ref. Coronavirus will go on for some months, I want to give those who have been very generous as stewards a break.

Thank you to all who have continued to contribute to the parish at this difficult time. At one point we were losing over £1,000 a week in the cash collection. Things have got a little better. Yesterday one of our parishioners handed me a bag that contained all the weekly envelopes for the weeks they were not at mass. So many of you have been so generous in changing the way you give to the parish or have made special donations. Even the Hall Fund has been growing due to your support. Thank You, Thank You, Thank You.

As we come to this so-called summer recess, I hope that in some strange way you will be able to get a break or things will slow down for you. Please keep in your prayers all those who are bereaved and all who are sick.

Please keep the Dockhead miracle going. I would love to think that our prayers have in some way contributed to the finding of a vaccine for this dreadful virus.
