Planning for Christmas

We are now considering the Christmas schedule of masses for this year taking into account the current restrictions. Christmas Day is a Friday and Boxing Day Saturday followed by The Feast of the Holy Family on Sunday 27th. We have decided due to numbers that we will not be able to have our annual midnight mass. To try and schedule the correct number of services, we have devised a questionnaire. Please would you complete one form per family/household and return no later than 15th November. The forms are available as you enter and leave the Church.

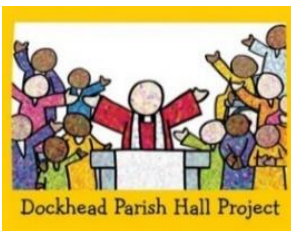
