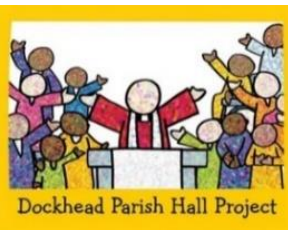
Notre Dame R.C. Girls' School Open Sessions
