All members of the congregation must:

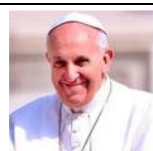
- *Wear a face covering; this is now law*

EASTER OFFERINGS

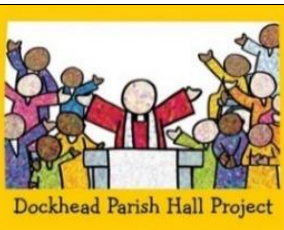
This is a reminder that the offerings you make at Easter are your personal gift to our Parish Priest. In this Diocese priests do not receive a salary, so he relies on your generosity!!
