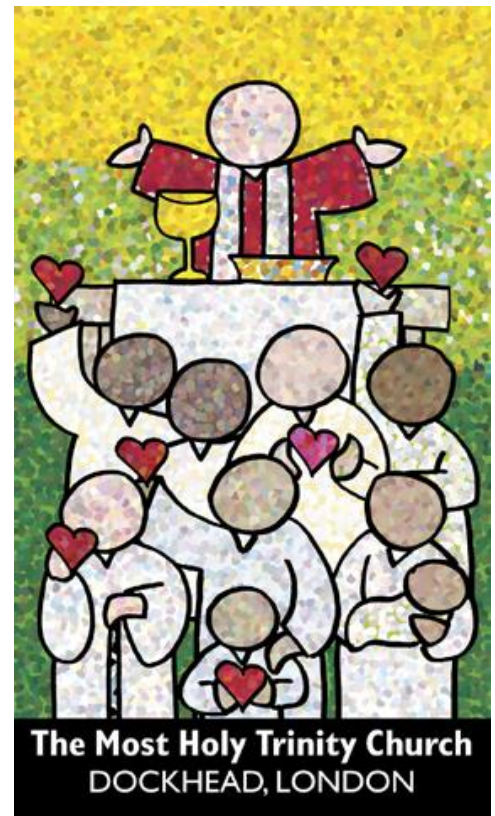

Pope Francis has asked us to do some preparatory work for a Synod on the subject of "Synodality" which will take place in 2023. Over the next few months we will arrange some meetings where we can look at some of the subject matter to prepare a parish response to be sent to the Diocese. It is hoped that a Diocesan document will be sent to Rome as participation of the Synod. Pope Francis is very keen that we have an opportunity to be an open voice in a Synodical Church. You may well be asking what is this all about? Over the next few months we will discern what a synodical church is meant to be.

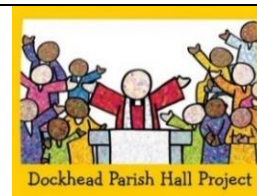
