Message from Canon Alan


Dear all

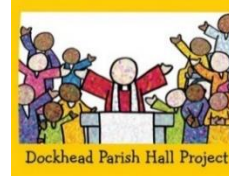
Mozambique
