Please remember: -

Marriages: At least one partner needs to be a practising Catholic and 6 months' notice is required. ***If you are planning on getting married this year and have not yet spoken to Canon Alan, please do so this week!***

Baptisms: At least one parent needs to be a practising Catholic and 6 months' notice is recommended.

For both sacraments it will be necessary to attend a course of instruction beforehand

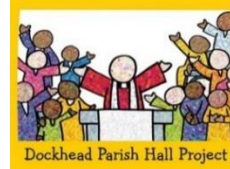
Covid-19 Omicron variant

With respect to the current situation with the omicron variant, when you attend Mass, we ask you to be considerate of others. We request that all members of the congregation:

- *Sanitize their hands upon entry and leaving*
- *Wear a face covering (both nose and mouth)*

- *We encourage people to get vaccinated and have the booster jab, when able*
