Next Sunday there will be a second collection for the Archbishop's Appeal. This is to cover what was previously in three separate collections – Archbishop's Administration Fund, Youth Work and Clergy Support Fund

To care for sick and retired priests in their old age and ill health. Supporting the ongoing formation of our priests and deacons. Providing on-going formation of clergy in active ministry. Supporting the work of the vocations team and formation of seminarians and deacons.
