We are collecting donations of warm clothes for the Manna Centre - our local organisation working with the homeless and those in need.



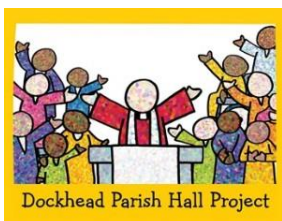
