A huge thank you for all the donations of warm clothes for the Manna Centre - our local organisation working with the homeless and those in need.

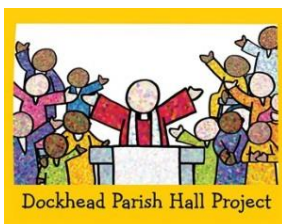


"Working with homeless people and those in need"
