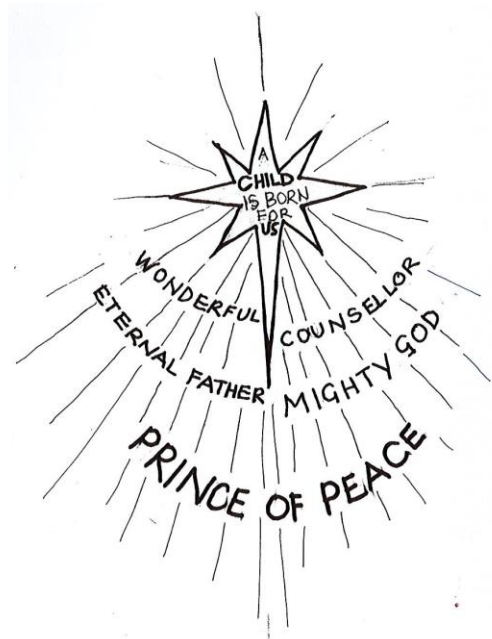

Marriages: At least one partner needs to be a practising Catholic and 6 months' notice is required.

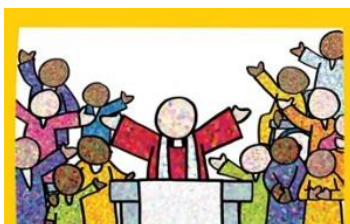
For both sacraments it will be necessary to attend a course of instruction beforehand
