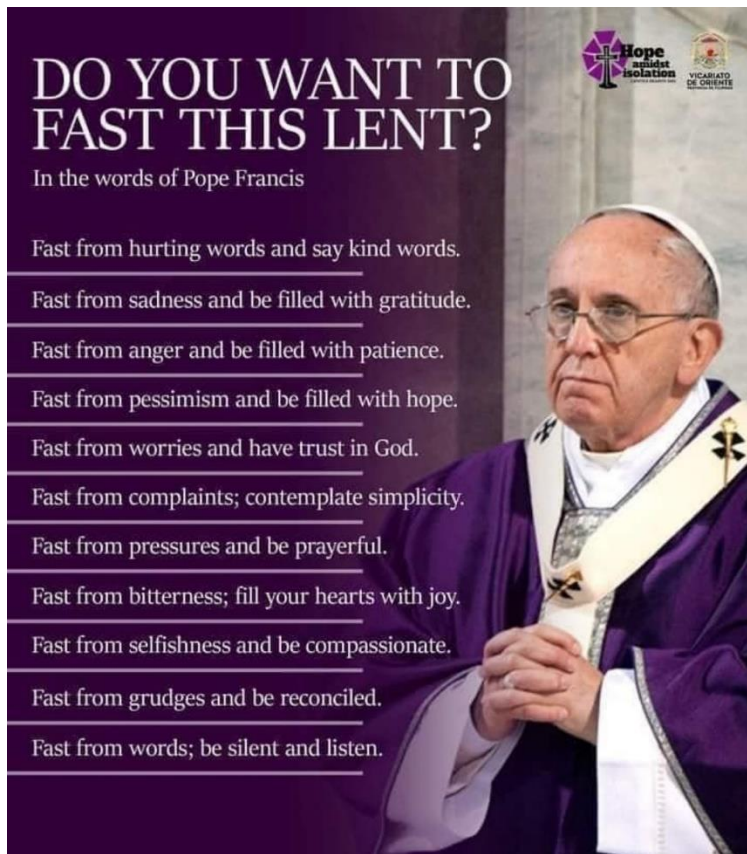
*The current club ends next month. Emails have
