The Universalis apps don't require an Internet connection.

- Illustrations in the About Today page.
- More pages: Mass Today (combining the Order of Mass with the readings and prayers), Spiritual Reading, Angelus, Lectio Divina, Rosary.
- A range of "Daily Books" for you to read in instalments, day by day.
- No Internet connection needed.
- All dates, not just a week.
- Official psalm translation for the Hours.
- More choice of layouts: page-turning as well as scrolling; and large print.

You can get a free trial of everything for a month. After that, you can choose whether you want to buy. You can get individual apps for your phone or tablet (it's about £10), or a single registration code which covers all your phones, tablets, computers, and e-books.

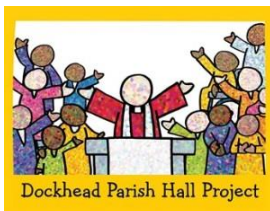
